Tampa YMCA & ECHO Help Disadvantaged Students Succeed

Annual YMCA Backpack Outreach Event to provide stuffed backpacks to 1,600 Greater Brandon area students.

WHAT: The Tampa YMCA is teaming up with Emergency Care Help Organization (ECHO) again to help Greater Brandon area students, in grades K-12, with backpacks stuffed with essential supplies for the school year. The YMCA Backpack Outreach Event is designed for pre-registered families facing financial hardship or recovering from job loss, fire or another qualifying emergency. Each registered child will receive a free backpack filled with age-appropriate school supplies. During the event, families will also participate in free health screenings, arts & crafts and giveaways.

A \$20 donation helps send one student back to school with a backpack full of school supplies. Community members can also donate backpacks, composition notebooks, college-rule paper, wide-rule paper and rulers.
